All students who audition/interview will participate. Performance auditions/interviews are limited to one minute. Stage Crew will have a short interview about the aspects of theatre the student would like to be involved in.

### **SUBMITTING FOR AUDITION/INTERVIEW:**

Students who wish to audition should have their parents email Variety Show Chair, Scott, at **ScottSandler24@hotmail.com** Please include "**Variety Show 2020**" in the subject of the email.

Please include the student's name, grade level, song/scene selection, or brief description of another type of performance, and any special accommodations that may be needed.

Please provide a digital copy of the music the student would like to use for their audition, by emailing it with your audition submission email. A capella auditions are permitted as well.

Musicians should provide their own instruments.

Audition times will be provided to all students who submit their audition email prior to the end of winter break. Those times will be distributed after winter break.

Auditions/interviews will be held on Thursday January 16, 2020 in the MPR from 2:30-4:30.

### **ADDITIONAL AUDITION INFORMATION:**

Theme: "Imagine Your World" will be a show highlighting KINDNESS, imagining a world kind enough to encourage and celebrate everyone's talents and imagination. Students will bring to the stage the world they imagine while singing, dancing, acting, playing music, rapping, performing magic, poetry, etc,. Our theme provides an opportunity for the students to select their performance material from a broad range of material, or even create their own.

No duplicate songs. Performers who select the same song/scene, will be given the opportunity to choose to perform it as a duo/group, or to make an alternate selection.

No Lip Syncing or singing with recorded vocals. A performer who prefers to not sing, is welcome to use choreography to perform the song they wish to use.

6th graders may perform an all-grade extended performance. The one minute audition time limit will be adjusted based on the number of 6th graders participating.

**FINALE:** In addition to a student's selected performance, they will also be participating in a finale performance that will include **ALL** cast members. Details will be provided after auditions.
